Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the electors of the CURVE LAKE First Nation will be held at the COMMUNITY CENTRE on FRIDAY, the 5<sup>TH</sup> day of MAY, 20 06, beginning at 6:00 o'clock P.M. and lasting for at least three hours, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the positions of chief and councillors on the Band Council of the said Band, for the next ensuing term. There are 8 councillor positions and one position for chief available. The election will be held at the COMMUNITY CENTRE on FRIDAY, the 16<sup>TH</sup> day of JUNE, 20 06.


Please note that any voter may nominate candidates by using a mail-in nomination form. **Voters residing off-reserve may only nominate candidates for the position of chief.** Voters residing on-reserve may nominate candidates for both chief and councillor positions. You can either deliver or mail-in a written nomination and a completed, signed and witnessed voter declaration form to the electoral officer before the time set for the nomination meeting OR you may nominate candidates orally at the nomination meeting. Mailed nominations not received by the electoral officer before the time set for nomination meeting are void. Also note that any voter may vote by mail-in ballot.

**Kinomaagewaapkong Advisory Committee Special Meeting**  
**Curve Lake Council Chambers**  
**April 11<sup>th</sup>, 10:00 a.m.**

Curve Lake First Nation was mandated by a General Assembly Chiefs' resolution in 1999 as "Keepers of the Teaching Rock" in the Petroglyphs Provincial Park. The Kinomaagewaapkong Advisory Committee was established By Council to advise them on matters relating to the Teaching Rock and the preferred operations of the Petroglyphs Provincial Park.

The Committee will be discussing three issues which will develop its recommended direction for Council to Ontario Parks. Whether a Committee member or not, Curve Lake First Nation members are welcome to attend and have their voices heard.

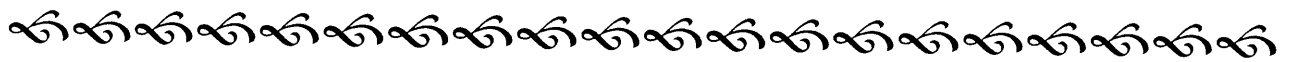
Normally Ontario Parks employees, representatives of the Government Ontario, are invited to attend Committee meetings because of joint interests in protecting the Rock and Ontario's "ownership" of the Park. Ontario Parks representatives will not be in attendance in this special meeting.

The issues to be discussed:

1. On direction from previous Committee meetings, Chief Knott requested a meeting with Minister David Ramsay to discuss the future direction which the First Nation wants to move to in order to meet the mandate of the Chiefs' Resolution. Minister Ramsay has directed a senior Government of Ontario official to meet with Chief Knott preliminary to a meeting with himself. So ... What is Curve Lake First Nation's long term goal with regards to the Teaching Rock? Is it joint management? Is it First Nation sole management with Ontario footing the bill for operations? Is it taking over ownership with all that ownership entails? Is it just the Rock? Is it the whole of the Park?
2. Access to the Rock. Aboriginal peoples see the spiritual significance of the Rock and many seek access to the physical glyphs' site. Ontario Parks protects the physical aspect. The Advisory Committee wants to protect both the physical and the spiritual integrity of Kinomaagewaapkong. This means limiting access to some degree. A proposal is before the Committee for discussion.
3. Photographing Kinomaagewaapkong is now prohibited by the public. Historical photo-journalists seek permission on an ongoing basis for photo and filming access. One such request is before Ontario Parks for consideration. While the decision is ultimately that of Ontario Parks they have requested the Committee's recommendation whether or not to give or deny permission.
