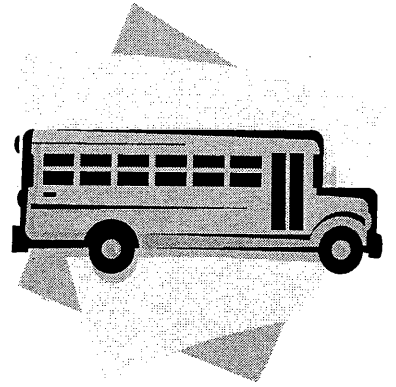
The Homework Program will begin Tuesday September 5, 2006.

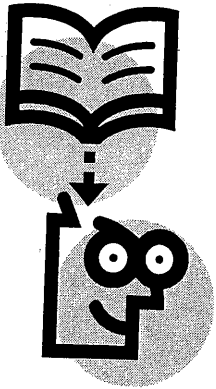
Daily Itinerary...

[A snack and drink will be provided]



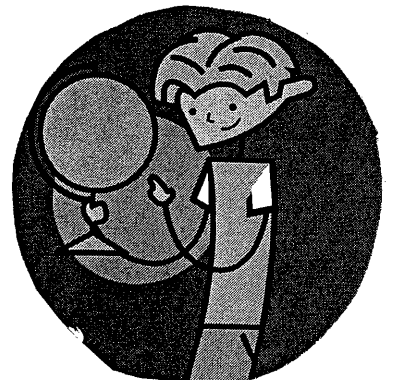
It's very important to go over these rules with your child/ren if they plan on attending the Homework Program.
