Notice of Nomination Meeting

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the electors of the CURVE LAKE First Nation will be held at the COMMUNITY CENTRE on FRIDAY, the 5TH day of MAY, 20 06, beginning at 6:00 o'clock P.M. and lasting for at least three hours, for the purpose of nominating candidates for the positions of chief and councillors on the Band Council of the said Band, for the next ensuing term. There are 8 councillor positions and one position for chief available. The election will be held at the COMMUNITY CENTRE on FRIDAY, the 16TH day of JUNE, 20 06.


Please note that any voter may nominate candidates by using a mail-in nomination form. **Voters residing off-reserve may only nominate candidates for the position of chief.** Voters residing on-reserve may nominate candidates for both chief and councillor positions. You can either deliver or mail-in a written nomination and a completed, signed and witnessed voter declaration form to the electoral officer before the time set for the nomination meeting OR you may nominate candidates orally at the nomination meeting. Mailed nominations not received by the electoral officer before the time set for nomination meeting are void. Also note that any voter may vote by mail-in ballot.

WHEN: Saturday, May 27th & Sunday May 28th, 2006

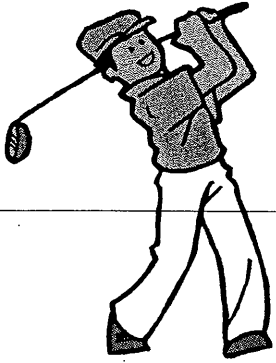
Limit: Two ½ ton loads per household. The wood is **NOT** to be removed

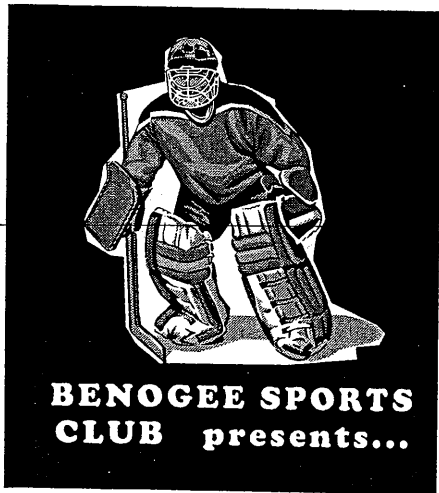

The congregation will be conducting the service on May 14th for Mother's Day.

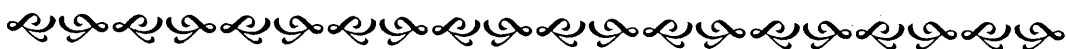
Celebration of Music Service will be on May 28th.
