FIRST NATION EMERGENCY ENERGY FUND

The Ontario Government has extended the EMERGENCY ENERGY FUND that was available through the Social Services Department in 2005.

The First Nation portion of the grant is intended for members of Curve Lake First Nation who reside in Curve Lake and who are:

1. low-income (\$22,000.00 or less per year) working sole support parents not on social assistance.
2. low-income families with children not on social assistance.

Interested applicants who meet the above requirements are invited to apply by April 7, 2006.

Necessary documentation to support your application must include the following:

Status card
Income verification
Bills for arrears in electricity, oil, or other source of fuel,
security deposits, or reconnection fees
Reasons for arrears

Please note that funding is limited and will be based on the number of applicants who qualify.
