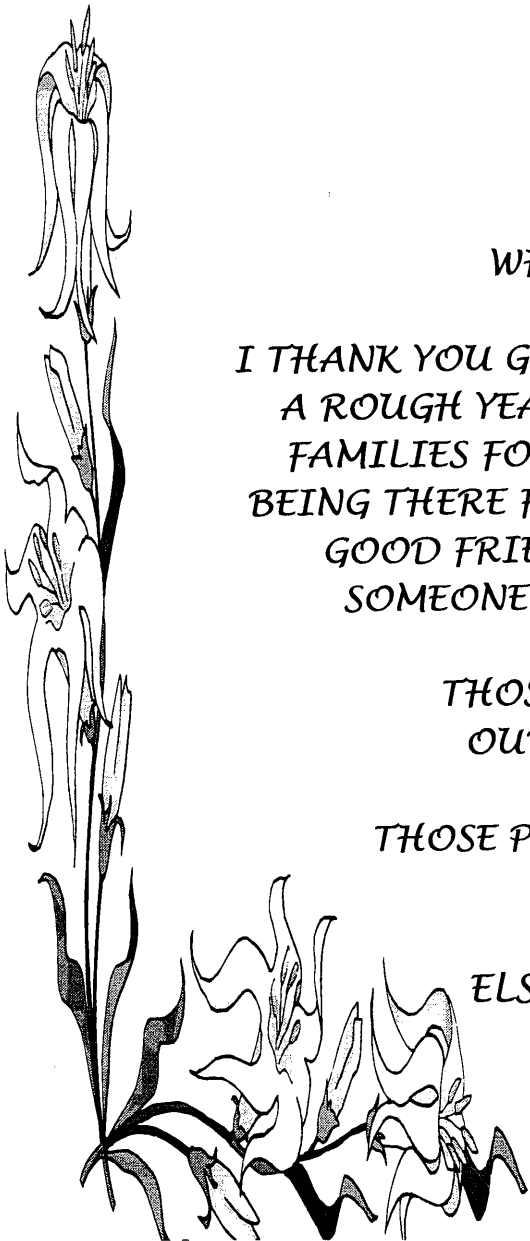

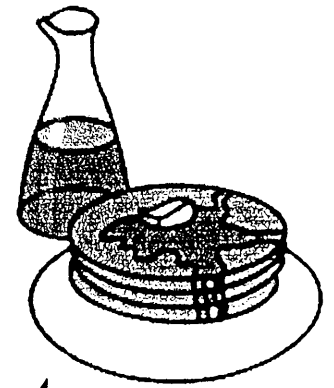

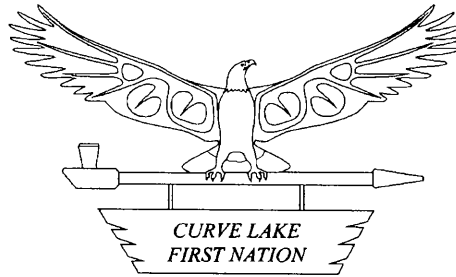

**Duties:** (Will be assessed during the interview)

- ◆ Responsible for hands-on computer and internet training to CAP site users.
- ◆ Responsible for maintenance and update of Curve Lake web site.
- ◆ Responsible for implementing Computer Fun Sessions.
- ◆ Responsible for compiling data on site usage and visits.
- ◆ Responsible for maintenance of hardware, software and other related sources
- ◆ Responsible for day to day liaison with public to provide info on site programs and services.
- ◆ Perform and other related duties as assigned.

**Qualifications:** (Applications must show necessary proof with application or will be automatically screened out)

- ◆ Youth between ages 15 and 30 years old.
- ◆ Also open to students enrolled in post-secondary institution OR completed at least one course at post-secondary institution
- ◆ Not currently in receipt of EI benefits
