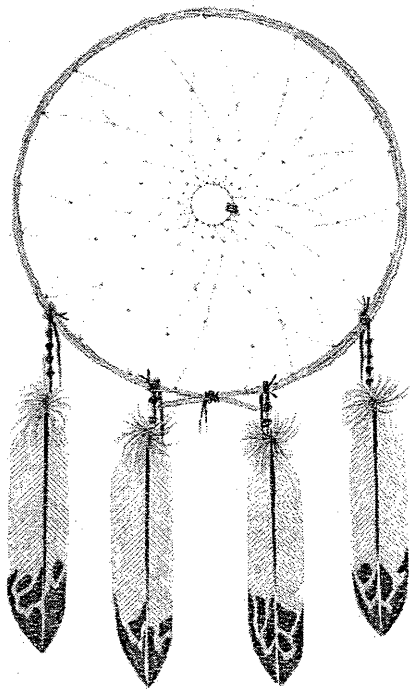

Curve Lake First Nation members are invited to come to the Curve Lake Community on December 19th at 7:00 p.m. and find out!

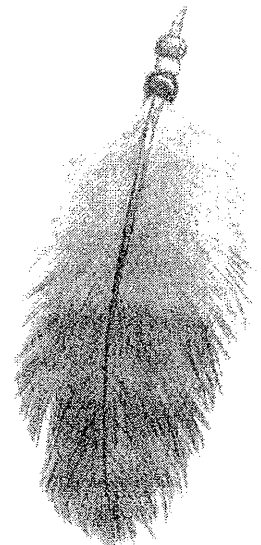
Council set up a Working Group to get things moving.

In the August 20th Council update to the community, it was reported that there would be no recommendation for a "Trust" to be set up but that the process for deciding how and what to spend money on would have community input from start to finish.

On December 19th, the Working Group will explain the recommended process so spending on community-identified projects can begin April 1st. Council has had a chance to review the process and have given it Agreement-in-Principle. Final approval is now up to those members who attend the December 19th meeting.

If you have an idea of someone, not from Council, who you would like to see monitor the progress of spending and project completion, come with the name in mind. You, the community, Will choose who will make up the five community members on the Oversight Committee.
