# LANDFILL AND CURBSIDE PICKUP

**Your increased efforts to divert garbage from the landfill site are greatly appreciated. Please see the summary below.**

## **Curbside Collection – Friday Morning**

**Steel and Aluminum Cans**-includes all metal food and beverage containers. Please remove lids on steel cans, place inside can and pinch closed.

**Metal Foil** – includes clean aluminum foil, pie plates and take-out food trays (please ball foil)

**Clear and Colored Glass Bottles & Jugs**-clear and colored glass food and beverage containers. **(does not include broken glass, drinking glasses, pyrex, light bulbs, window glass or ceramics)**

**Plastic Tubs, Bottles, Jugs**- all plastic containers eg pop bottles yogurt or margarine tubs, water and windshield washer jugs, shampoo, dish soap and bleach bottles. **Does not include containers from hazardous or petroleum products like motor oil containers**

**Gable-topped containers** – Includes polycoated paper dairy, juice and molasses containers

**Drinking boxes**- clean juice, milk or tetra-pak drinking boxes

**Newspapers, magazines and phone books**-includes inserts from newspapers and magazines, phone books etc.

**Soft cover books**-includes bound catalogues and paperback books (please pack in separate bag)

**Mixed paper**-includes household and office paper, junk mail fax paper envelopes

**Film Plastic**-includes plastic milk, shopping and dry cleaning bags, wrap from toilet paper and paper towels and bags from frozen foods.

## **Curbside Collection – Wednesday Morning**

**Cardboard**-please break down all boxes to make your cardboard bundle as small as possible.

**Styrofoam**-includes foam cups and plates, meat and poultry trays, clamshell takeout containers and foam egg containers. **Please no popcorn type, or blue or pink Styrofoam.**

**DUMPING OF CONSTRUCTION WASTE AT THE LANDFILL REQUIRES A PERMIT WHICH CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE BAND OFFICE FOR \$150.00**

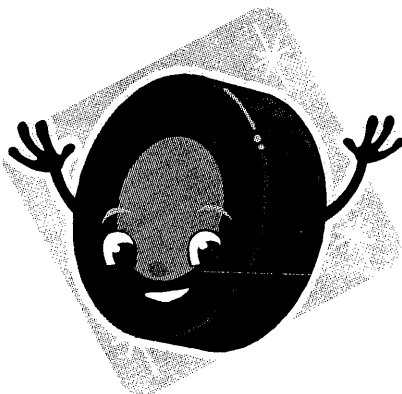

### “Rekindling of the Sacred Fire”

Curve Lake First Nation members are welcome to come to a Planning Meeting for the planning event of the “Rekindling of the Sacred fire” to take place sometime in 2007.

The Planning Meeting will be on Sunday, November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2006 at noon at the portable across from the Curve Lake School. (“The Drop-In Centre”)

The Fire will be an important cultural event for all to bring about more cultural awareness, strengthen our Anishnaabe identity and bring us together as Anishnaabe family and community. This will be done as it was in 1988, when the Sacred Fire was first brought to Curve Lake through Curve Lake First Nation Native Studies Education. (Future Newsletters will detail some of the origin, history, and good results of the lighting of the Sacred Fire 18 years ago.)

This is a Pot Luck “Informal” Meeting to be held in “tradition” – with Circle, Sharing Anishnaabe Language and Songs, Good Food and a Good Time while planning.
