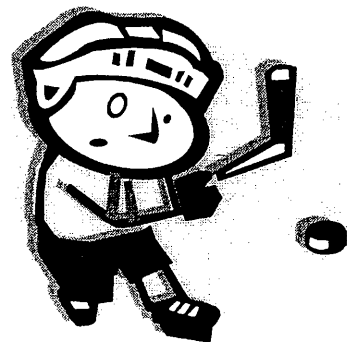
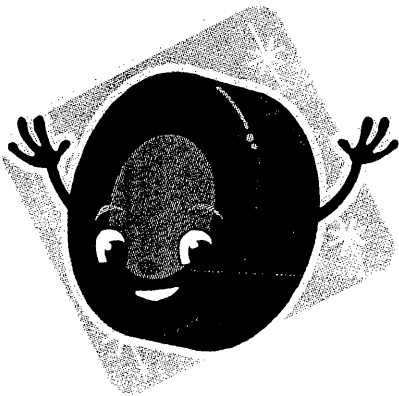

**Our Objective:** The fund will provide financial support to community projects that do not have another adequate source of funding.

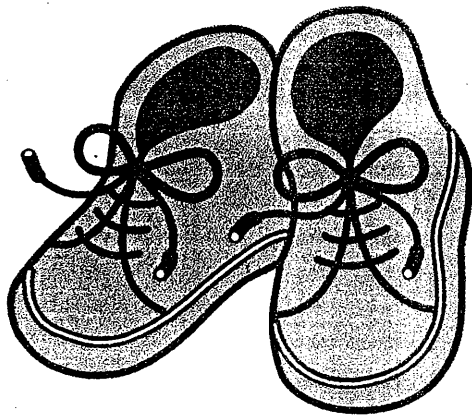
It is our honor to welcome all participants who submit logo entries, however the true honor is having your logo represent our Curve Lake Community Gaming Revenue Fund.

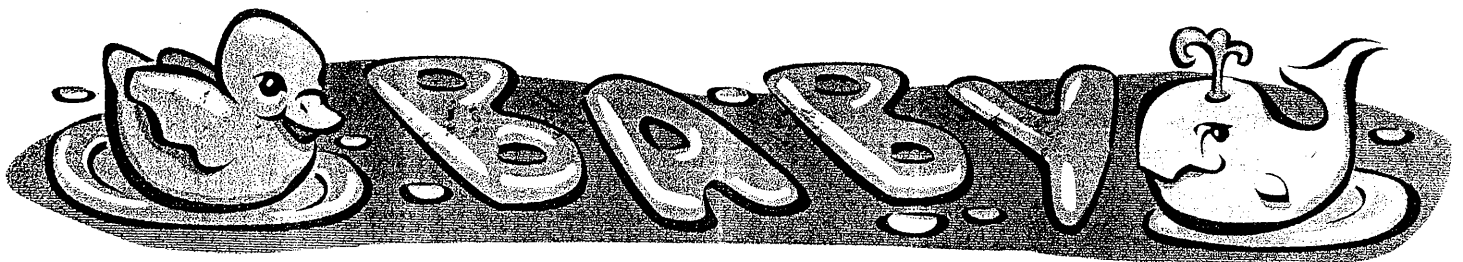

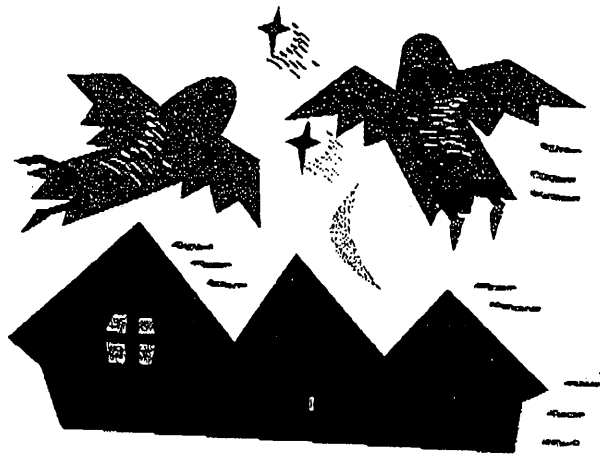
