Curve Lake Community Gaming Revenue Fund

Amendments to the Guidebook

Changes from Community input are as follows:

Pages 1 and 2 – 6 definitions have been added to the glossary of terms:

Grant: a grant is a type of financial aid based on financial need that does not have to be repaid. For the purpose of this fund, grants are awarded to successful applicants as per the following guidelines.

(Lead) Applicant: the person requesting funding. This person takes responsibility for all management duties as they relate to the project/activity fitting within the criteria for Individual Project Managers, Group Project Managers, and Departments, Committees and Corporations.

Individual Project Manager: a single person applying to the fund, intending to manage projects fitting within the criteria for individual project managers, as listed on page 5 of this guidebook.

Group Project Manager: an individual applying on behalf of two or more people to the fund, intending to manage projects fitting within the criteria for Group Project Managers as listed on page 6 of this guidebook. The majority of Group (or 75%) must be Curve Lake First Nation status members.

Community Benefit: all approved projects/activities must demonstrate 100% benefit to the entire Curve Lake Community. This will be assessed on a case-by-case basis; some examples are social betterment, beautification, improved environment, healthy lifestyle, employment created, etc.

Curve Lake Community: all members of Curve Lake First Nation, living on or off reserve.

Page 3 – About the Curve Lake Community Gaming Revenue Fund “The Curve Lake Community Gaming Revenue Fund is a grant program designed to provide Curve Lake First Nation membership...”

Page 5 – ELIGIBILITY – Individual Project Manager – changes made under “Eligible Costs” the last point reading “the cost of the CPIC can be included in the application” has been added.

Page 7 - ELIGIBILITY – Group Project Manager – changes made under “Eligible Costs” the last point reading “the cost of the CPIC can be included in the application” has been added.

Page 8 – Title reads “Checklist for Group Project Managers”

Page 15 – How Your Application is Assessed

#4. If a project is partially supported by other funding sources, the amount of funding needed to offset the cost must be identified.

#5. If a project is partially supported by revenue generation, the amount of funding needed to offset the cost must be identified.

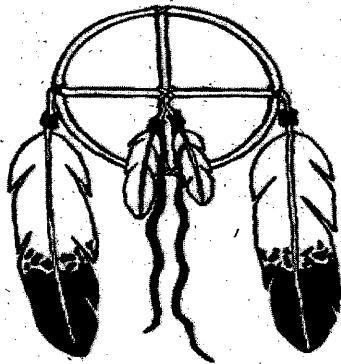
#6. Applying party must not be in receipt of any personal gain as a result of funding approval, and must understand that management of any such funds is voluntary.

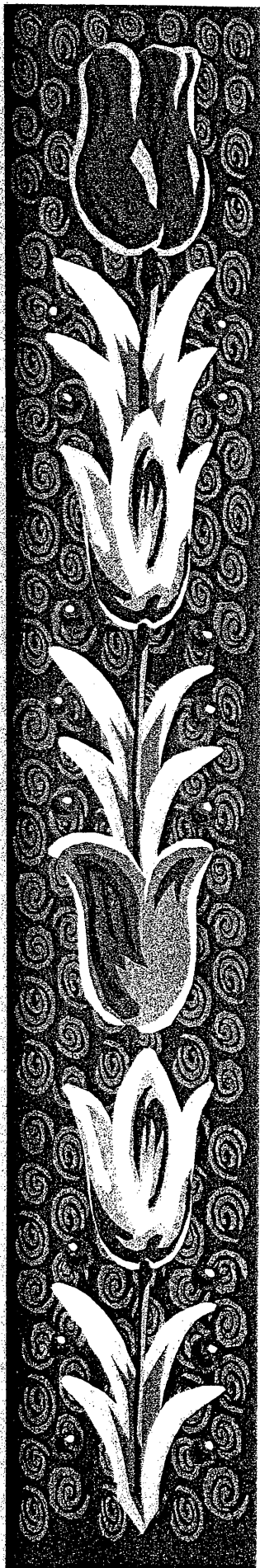

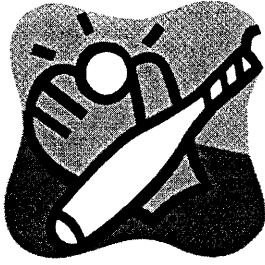

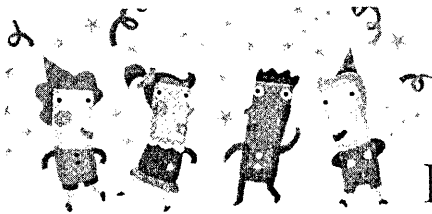
